

## ORDINANCE NO. 201-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 107 OF CHAPTER 1 OF  
TITLE 18 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TENNESSEE, THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 107 of Chapter 1 of Title 18 of the Municipal Code of the City of Union City is hereby amended by deleting Section 107 in its entirety and replacing it with the following

18-107. Main extensions. The extensions of water mains and appurtenances shall be subject to approval by the mayor and council based upon the recommendations of the Union City Public Works Department.

Prospective customers and/or developers requesting water main and appurtenance extensions in any undeveloped area within corporate limits and/or water main extensions outside the corporate limits, shall pay all costs of installation and testing. All new main extensions shall have all appropriate water taps installed and service lines run to each lot with a curb stop and meter box installed and set on or within three (3) feet of the property line and no further than five (5) feet from back of curb or roadway, so as not to interfere with future driveways and/or further development. At no time shall one tap and service line feed more than one meter. At no time shall a meter and meter box be set in a driveway or sidewalk. All installation will be subject to the AWWA standards and regulations as adopted by the city and shall be subject to any other applicable city ordinances.

Upon approval of water main extensions, the developer shall pay a connection fee for each planned water service line before work begins. The amount of the connection fee shall be established by the mayor and council by resolution.

All water main extensions under this section shall be made using materials approved by the Union City Public Works Department. A list of city approved materials will be available at both City Hall and The Union City Public Works Department. The approved materials list may change from time to time due to new technology and improved materials.

All water main extension installations shall be inspected by a water distribution licensed employee of Union City Public Works Department or a representative hired by the city. All inspections shall take place before any cover is placed on new installations.


Upon completion of such extensions, inspections, tests, and upon approval by the city, such water mains shall become the property of the city. The person or entity paying the cost of such mains shall execute any written instruments requested or required by the city to provide evidence of the city's title to such mains.

The provisions of this Title 18, Chapter 1, and its sections shall apply to all areas where the city provides service.

For installations under this section, pipe not less than six (6) inches in diameter shall be used in any water main extension installation on public property or easement granted to the city as an integral part of the city's public water system: provided that, under certain conditions, primarily in rural areas with the approval of the Director of Public Works, a smaller line (4") may be used for distribution to a limited number of customers on existing public roads or for circulation of water in limited areas. No line with a diameter of less than six (6) inches may be used where fire protection is required.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from and after its passage on second and final reading, and after publication in the official city newspaper.


