

ORDINANCE NO. 164-16

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AN INSPECTION FEE UPON RETAIL FOOD STORE WINE LICENSEES LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF UNION CITY

WHEREAS, Section 57-3-101, Tennessee Code Annotated, provides that a municipality has the authority to impose by ordinance an inspection fee upon retail food store wine licensees located within municipalities; and


WHEREAS, the purpose of the inspection fee is to provide a means of regulating, inspecting, and supervising the sale of wine in retail food stores located within the City of Union City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Council Members of the City of Union City, Tennessee, that:

SECTION 1: Inspection Fee. Under the authority of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-501, there is hereby levied upon each retail food store wine licensee located within the City of Union City, an inspection fee in an amount equal to eight (8%) of the wholesale price of wine supplied by a wholesaler to retail food store wine licensees located within the City of Union City. The inspection fee shall be collected and paid to the City as prescribed by Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 57-3-502 and 503.


SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from and after its passage on second and final reading and after publication in the official City Newspaper.


