

ORDINANCE NO. 234-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TO AMEND TITLE 15 – MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAFFIC, AND PARKING, CHAPTER 6, PARKING BY CREATING THE FOLLOWING AS SECTION 15-616 – RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AND TRAILER PARKING.

WHEREAS, certain revisions to the Union City Municipal Code are believed to be necessary and in the public interest; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council members of the City of Union City that the Union City Municipal Code be amended by adding Title 15, Chapter 6, Section 15-616: Recreational Vehicle and Trailer Parking as follows:

SECTION 1. 15-616. Recreational Vehicle and Trailer Parking.


- 1) For purposes of this section camping trailer, motor home, oversized vehicle, recreational vehicle, slide-in camper, temporary recreational vehicle, trailer, storage containers, and dumpster/roll off shall have the follow meanings:
 - a) "Camping trailer" shall mean a vehicular unit designed for human habitation mounted on wheels and constructed with collapsible partial sidewalls which fold and unfold, and which is towed by another vehicle.
 - b) "Dumpster/Roll-off" shall mean a container whose use is for the disposal of garbage/trash or removal of construction or household waste.
 - c) "Motor home" shall mean a vehicular unit designed for human habitation built on or permanently attached to a self-propelled motor vehicle chassis, chassis cab or van, which becomes an integral part of the completed vehicle.
 - d) "Oversized vehicle" shall mean any vehicle or combination of vehicles that exceeds twenty-two feet in length or eighty-four inches in width.
 - e) "Recreational vehicle" shall mean a camping trailer, motor home, slide-in camper, temporary recreation vehicle or trailer.
 - f) "Slide-in camper" shall mean a portable unit, consisting of a roof, and sides, designed to be loaded onto and unloaded from the bed of a pickup truck.
 - g) "Temporary recreational vehicle" shall mean any motor vehicle altered and equipped for sleeping or human habitation.
 - h) "Trailer" shall mean a portable unit mounted on wheels, of such a size and weight as not to require special highway movement permits when drawn by a motor vehicle. (i.e., Utility trailer, Boat & Trailer, etc.)
 - i) "Storage Container" shall mean any object used for permanent or temporary storage of items.

- 2) Any of the above defined vehicles and/or items shall be prohibited from being parked/placed on a City Street or City Owned Property with the following exemptions:
 - a) A motor home, slide-in camper or temporary recreational vehicle may for up to 24 hours park immediately in front of the residence of the owner or lessee of the recreational vehicle or unattached trailer for the purpose of loading, unloading or other related activity incidental to preparing the recreational vehicle or unattached trailer for travel or returning from travel and does not create a traffic hazard. Trailers while attached to a motor vehicle may park immediately in front of a residence or business while business is being conducted, (i.e., Lawn Care, Delivery of merchandise, etc.) until completion of service is rendered and does not create a traffic hazard.
 - b) All previously defined vehicles and trailers while parked shall be marked with reflectors and/or emergency cones clearly visible by approaching traffic.
 - c) All vehicles and trailers must adhere to all other parking restrictions as described in Union City Municipal Code Title 15 Chapter 6.

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SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, the **PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.**


