

**ORDINANCE NO. 236-22****AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF  
LOW SPEED AND MEDIUM SPEED VEHICLES ON  
CERTAIN STREETS IN UNION CITY, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1 of Title 15 of the Municipal Code of the City of Union City, Tennessee, establishes ordinances regarding motor vehicles, traffic and parking; and

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 55-8-101(36) defines “low speed vehicle” and T.C.A. § 55-8-101(38) defines “medium speed vehicle”; and

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 55-8-191(a)(2) and T.C.A. § 55-8-191(b)(1) provide that a Municipality may prohibit the operation of low speed vehicles and medium speed vehicles on any road under its jurisdiction if prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and City Council of The City of Union City, have determined that it is necessary in the interest of safety of those who utilize streets of The City of Union City to prohibit the operation of low speed vehicles and medium speed vehicles on certain streets and roadways within The City of Union City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TENNESSEE, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** The Municipal Code of The City of Union City is hereby amended by adding Section 15-129 as follow


15-129. **Prohibition to operate low speed vehicles and medium speed vehicles on certain streets.** It is unlawful to operate low speed vehicles and medium speed vehicles as defined in T.C.A. § 55-8-101(36) and T.C.A. § 55-8-101(38) on the following streets and roadways within the corporate limits of The City of Union City, Tennessee: Reelfoot Avenue, East Main Street, West Main Street, Nailing Drive, Section Line Road, Miles Avenue, Cheatham Street, Pleasant Valley Avenue, and Old Troy Road.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from and after its passage on second and final reading and after publication in the official City Newspaper.


