- B. That the Applicant will, upon receipt by the City Clerk of a satisfactory report from the designated investigator, purchase all applicable business licenses.
- C. That the Applicant will not allow any permit issued to Applicant under the provisions of said Peddler's Ordinance to be used by any person other than the one to whom it is issued.

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- D. That the Applicant agrees to abide by and operate under all of the provisions of the Peddler's Ordinance of the City of Union City, Tennessee, as adopted on final reading on January 15, 1963; and, as amended by City Ordinance No. 7-84, approved and adopted on final reading on November 1, 1983.
- E. That the Applicant understands that all permits issued pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter shall expire on June 30, of each year; and, an Applicant seeking renewal of a permit after expiration must submit a new application in accordance with Section 5-203 of said Peddler's Ordinance.
