TAX LEVY

The tax levy for 2027 is set at \$1.6977 per \$100.00 of assessed property value.

STREET/PUBLIC WORKS FUND

The activities of Street/Public Works are budgeted in the General Fund and are not shown in a separate fund. The Revenue from State gasoline tax is used to help finance the street paving work.

GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND

The budget for the Union City School System is prepared by the Director of Schools. The City of Union City makes a direct cash appropriation to the Union City Schools and provides the buildings. These expenditures are budgeted in the City’s General Fund.

DEBT SERVICE FUND

A separate debt service fund is not maintained. Line items are included in the expenditures of the City’s General Fund sufficient to pay the fiscal year bond principal and interest obligations of the City.

A copy of proposed Ordinance is on file in the office of the City Manager in the Municipal Building, 408 S. Depot Street, Union City, Tennessee, and may be inspected between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Monday through Thursday and between the hours of 7:30AM to 11:00AM on Friday.
