Notice is hereby given that a vacancy exists in the classified service of the City of Union City for a full-time employee.



## GS 3.6- Parks, Recreation, and Cemeteries Laborer

Pay Grade 11

### DEFINITION

This is unskilled work of a manual nature.

An employee in this class is responsible for performing simple tasks requiring considerable physical exertion. Duties may involve the use of mechanical equipment. Work is usually performed under the immediate direction of an employee of higher grade; however, constant supervision is not necessary for recurring tasks once they are learned. Work is reviewed at frequent intervals for quality, quantity, and conformance to instructions.

### SOME TYPICAL DUTIES

1. Operating a weedeater, leaf blower, pressure washer, hedge trimmers, and mixing 2 stroke fuel correctly.
2. Clean and dispose of trash in designated areas as well as the shop and workplace.
3. Trims trees and bushes; cuts grass.
4. Operates mechanical equipment; starts compressor and runs auger; drives truck on limited jobs; operates power tools; operates a small cement mixer.
5. Loading and unloading refuse, garbage, materials, limbs, and/or any other common labor duties pertaining to general city operations.
6. Performs related work as required.

### RECRUITING REQUIREMENTS

#### KNOWLEDGE, SKILL, AND ABILITY

Knowledge of the use and care of picks, shovels, weed eaters, blowers, lawn mowers, and similar manual tools; ability to understand and follow oral instructions about manual duties; ability to perform heavy manual labor for extended periods, often under adverse weather conditions; ability to obtain an operator's license from the State of Tennessee may be required for some positions in this class.

#### EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

Experience in performing heavy manual work.
